



VALLEY CEMETERY

Surveyed by Howard F. Bell in July 1915. It sets on a Forest Service lease. The enclosed part of the cemetery is Blocks 9 through 17. There is no name marker.



They are listed from the gate left Block #19 – up the fence line north through #14 and #11 – down the middle #10 - #15 - #18 and back up the right side Block #17 - #16 - #9. The blank lines are empty lots, eight on each side of each Block.
